The course helps students acquire a good level of general and historical knowledge. It gives them in a real capacity to analyse facts, texts and sources of all kinds.

These skills can lead in particularly to teaching entrance exams after the MEEF course, master's degrees specialised in history and other subjects, to administrative entrance exams and to professions in the sectors of culture, journalism and documentation.

A shared portal course for the degree specialisations at the Faculty of Human and Social Sciences has been set up in term 1: it includes a general introduction to the human and social sciences, an overview of the different constitutive disciplines, providing a choice of orientation from term 2, a series of interdisciplinary courses and methodological tools.
