Course **Antiquity and Humanities**

Aims

- § Deeper knowledge of the languages of Antiquity (Greek and Latin) through lessons pooled with the universities Lyon 2 and Lyon 3. With a team of over 20 lecturer-researchers who are highly specialised in all aspects of Antique culture, this course comes second only to Paris in terms of excellence (lessons taken in Lyon)
 - § A course in French language and literature, from the Middle Ages to today, along with Modern Literature (lessons in Saint-Etienne).
 - § Opening onto other fields through interdisciplinary courses: modern language, I.T, Humanities, Latin/Greek, Mythology, the Bible, a wide range of options (lessons in Saint-Etienne).
- The ALL field is organised into two portals, “Arts” (Plastic arts and Musicology) and “Literature and Languages”. The “Arts” and “Literature and Languages” portals are based on four types of skills, which are mainly interdisciplinary and linguistic, helping to make reorientation easier.

Admission

Baccalaureate, preferably general.

Skills

- § Analyse an issue and organise ideas.
- § Carry out a textual research and make use of information (textual analysis).
- § Construct a written and / or spoken communication.
- § Transmit knowledge and methods.

After the course

Continuing studies

- § Master’s degree in French, Greek or Latin literature.
- § MEEF (teaching) master’s degree (primary or secondary school teachers): CAPES in Classical Literature, which leads to teaching positions in French and Ancient languages, which are currently some of the most accessible entrance exams.
- § Master’s degree in publishing, heritage, etc.

Job openings

The degree gives students wide general knowledge, a deeper understanding of the French language, both written and spoken, as well as reasoning techniques. It provides training in analysing texts and other media in a range of fields (philosophy, history of ideas, arts), in textual research and in working independently or in a group. It opens the way not only to teaching and publishing professions, but also to all professions linked to journalism, tourism, heritage, the administration and archiving. It is also an excellent preparation for entrance exams for speech therapists (study of language) and administrative entrance exams.
