Aims

The AFL course gives students a solid basis in two modern languages at the same level (with English as language A for all students and a choice between German, Spanish, Italian or Portuguese for language B (beginners accepted)). The aim is to give students skills of a directly professional kind (international trade, management, law, accountancy-management, I.T., etc.).

The ALL field is organised in two portals, "Arts" (Plastic arts and Musicology) and "Literature and Languages". The "Arts" and "Literature and Languages" portals are based on four types of skills, which are essentially interdisciplinary and linguistic, helping to make reorientation easier.

Admission

Baccalaureate, preferably general.

Skills

- § Developing access to specific documentation adapted to given subjects
- § Constructing or adapting communication to an international dimension
- § Taking part in the development of relations and exchanges in a business context
- § Taking part in developing cultural facilitation projects
- § Communicating and writing in two foreign languages

- § Master's degree in applied foreign languages (all options)
- § Master's degree in translation and interpreting
