Aims

The Public administration degree gives students a legal, economic and general administrative culture.

The aim is twofold:

- § First, to open up access to contract employment in the public sector, local authorities and hospitals (categories A and B).
- § Second, thanks to solid foundations, students will also have access to master's degrees in the areas of law, economic administration, and particularly in public law, public administration, public management, public policy, etc.

The introductory course in the first term leads to two specialisations: Law and Public Administration. It also provides reorientation to the Economics and management specialisation.

- § To mobilise, express and make use of fundamental knowledge in public law, public finances, economics and general knowledge.
- § To work independently: set priorities, to manage one's time.

- § To conduct a study: present an issue; construct and develop an argument; interpret results; develop a synthesis, propose extensions.
