Aims

The **Law Course** provides students with a general legal culture, as well as the methodological tools used by lawyers. Even though immediate access to employment will be limited, this course can lead to integration into professional life. In the second year, it can lead to vocational degree studies. It also opens the way to a series of master's degrees, especially in the fields of Law, Economics and Management.

The **Law, Societies and Languages Course** is addressed to a group of 25 motivated students, who are selected by the teaching team in each academic year. It adds to the Law course with additional courses around three central units (political and legal culture, reinforcement of legal disciplines, English). The aim is to maximise chances of access to legal master's degrees, and beyond that, to more selective employment (upper category A in the public services, for example).

The **Law - Medical Affairs Course** gives law students training in the requirements of the new health professions, following orientations adapted to their courses. Students will be oriented towards specialised missions, to work as regulatory assistants or project managers in clinics and hospitals, to conduct medical promotion or take medical delegate roles in e-health, etc. This course is also recommended for those wishing to continue their studies with master's degrees in applied business law in the health sector at the University of Saint-Etienne.

The introductory course in the first term leads to two specialisations: Law and Public Administration.

Admission

Baccalaureate or equivalent.

Skills

- § Deploy and apply legal principles that are specific to a context
- § Take part in implementing legal rules (conventions, contracts, etc.)
- § Contribute to legal applications in human resources management

After the course

Continuing studies

- § Vocational degree after the 2nd year of the bachelor's degree
- § Master's degree in the field of law, economics, management
- § Legal master's degrees
- § Master's degree in Law and health affairs

The degree can also be reinforced by other qualifications or skills (languages, I.T., business, art, etc.).

Job openings

Magistrate, lawyer, civil servant, company lawyer and more generally, all the professions linked to law: legal attaché, regulatory assistant or project managers in clinics and hospitals, medical promotion or medical delegate for e-health. Some careers, however, require additional qualifications or an entrance exam.
