Aims

The sociology degree is a general degree that is firmly oriented towards carrying out work in the field. It helps students acquire the knowledge and methods specific to Sociology and Anthropology, themed knowledge linked to the specialisations of lecturer-researchers in the department and the laboratories they work with but also opening onto other disciplines in the human and social sciences.

The course gives students skills based on group work, studies in the field and the techniques that are specific to sociological enquiries (statistics, observations, interviews), the use of qualitative and quantitative data processing software and reading (reports, commentaries, synthesis, summaries, argumentation) and lastly the new information and communications technology. It also gives students general knowledge that can be applied to different areas.

A shared portal for the degree specialisations at the Faculty of Human and social sciences has been set up in term 1: it includes a general introduction to human and social sciences, an overview of the different constitutive disciplines, providing a choice of orientation from term 2, a series of interdisciplinary courses and methodological tools.
