NOTES ABOUT THE COURSE

Certain modules are taught with the Business Master 2, "law and business" speciality. Some sectors are shared with the "Health Engineering" Master in medicine and included in medicine brochures. Medicine students on the course are enrolled in medicine.

Coaching lessons are partly provided by the university's module for 8 hrs.
