

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT GUIDE



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Welcome to Jean Monnet University !

Dear students, researchers, and members of our international community, we are delighted to welcome you to our prestigious institution.

Your arrival marks the beginning of a unique academic and cultural adventure, and we wish to make this transition as smooth as possible.

To help you navigate through this maze of formalities, we have prepared a list of essential documents that will be your allies in this new chapter of your life.



Defore your departure:

- Passport: Ensure that your passport is up-to-date, including the personal information pages and validity dates. For EU citizens, a valid identity card will suffice.
- Visa: If you are coming from a non-EU country, you must have a valid visa with an entry stamp.
- Proof of Civil Status: A complete copy of your birth certificate will be necessary to prove your civil status.
- Transcripts: Remember to have your transcripts translated into French to facilitate administrative and academic procedures.
- Proof of Income: You will need to provide proof of income showing that you have more than €615 per month to support yourself.



- Residence Permit: If you are a non-EU citizen, you must obtain a residence permit upon your arrival.
- Proof of Residence: To prove your residency in France, prepare a gas bill or a rental agreement in your name.
- Proof of Enrollment or Student ID: Once you are enrolled at the university, a proof of enrollment or your student ID will be necessary for various administrative procedures.
- Approved E-photo: You will need a digital photo that meets official standards. You can obtain one here:



• IBAN (International Bank Account Number): These documents will be essential for your banking transactions in France. If you need assistance with opening a bank account in Saint-Étienne, feel free to contact the team at the following address: welcome-student@univ-st-etienne.fr.

Visa & Residence Permit (non-EU citizens only):

> Upon your arrival, you have 3 months to validate your visa online.



After validating your visa, apply for a residence permit on the ANEF website.

Note: Residence permit processing times can be lengthy, so we recommend applying as soon as possible. $\underline{\Lambda}$

The Students Welcome Desk team will dedicate specific time to assist you with this process. We will send you an email with the details including the date. (Limited spaces: registration required)



Social security & health



Enrollment in the French Social Security system, specifically with the Caisse Primaire d'Assurance Maladie (CPAM), is a mandatory step for all students to ensure optimal coverage of health expenses. This enrollment allows you to benefit from basic healthcare coverage in France, including doctor visits, hospitalizations, medications, and more.

Once enrolled, you will receive your Carte Vitale, an essential tool to simplify all your healthcare procedures:

- Simplified Payments: Present your Carte Vitale to healthcare professionals (doctors, pharmacists, etc.) to benefit from direct billing, meaning you won't have to pay upfront for medical expenses covered by the health insurance.
- Fast Reimbursements: With the vital card, your healthcare expenses will be automatically and quickly reimbursed to your bank account.
- Streamlined Procedures: No more filling out paper claim forms for each consultation or medication purchase; everything is automated.





For students who are EU citizens, remember to request your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

Upon signing the lease:

- Payment of the first month's rent + a security deposit (= 1 month's rent) Having a guarantor:
 - For individuals under 31 years old: Visale guarantee (<u>www.visale.fr</u>) FREE. Note: Visale guarantee must be requested before signing the lease.
 - For individuals over 31 years old: <u>www.garantme.fr</u> (approximately €250/year)

Move-in inspection:

• Take photos to ensure you can recover your security deposit in case of dispute with the landlord when you move out.

How to get to Saint-Étienne?



By plane Lyon Saint-Exupéry Airport

From Paris, you need to take a TGV (high-speed train) from Gare de Lyon to Saint-Étienne, which takes about 3 hours.

From Lyon Saint-Exupéry Airport, follow the signs within the airport to take the Rhônesxpress shuttle to Lyon-Part-Dieu train station (departures every 20 minutes from 5 AM to midnight).

Once at Lyon-Part-Dieu station, take the train to Saint-Étienne (Châteaucreux train station)

By train Gare de Lyon

Whether from Gare de Lyon in Paris (in 3 hours) or Gare de Lyon-Part-Dieu in Lyon (in 45 minutes), purchase a ticket from a selfservice machine, ticket counter, or online.

Get off at Saint-Étienne Châteaucreux Station.

By public transport

Bus

DFrom Lyon Saint-Exupéry airport, take a bus from the airport bus station.


It will take you to Saint-Étienne in 40 minutes. ATTENTION: remember to book well in advance, as there are only a few routes available!
